

Federal funding approved for YMCA site in Oakley

The Delta Family YMCA received a financial shot in the arm from Contra Costa supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors approved designating \$100,000 from community development block grant-recovery funds toward the construction of the new YMCA site in Oakley.

The YMCA plans to build a 25,000-square-foot facility at the original site on O'Hara Avenue but has had problems securing funding.

The funds approved by supervisors come from more than \$900,000 made available by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Brentwood's Veterans Memorial Building Incorporated and Opportunity Junction, a job-training program in Antioch, were also awarded grants for remodeling their current facilities.
