Supervisor presents final plan for safety and beautification improvements to Bailey Road

Supervisor Federal Glover is hosting a Town Hall in Bay Point to discuss the final proposal for safety and beautification improvements along the Bailey Road corridor.

Over the past year, Contra Costa County planning staff, CalTrans and Bay Point residents have been working together on various alternatives to make the corridor safer for pedestrians and bicyclists.

"Bailey Road is one of the main gateways into Bay Point and it should be more welcoming and at the same time safer for everyone who uses it," said Glover, whose District V includes Bay Point, the largest unincorporated community in Contra Costa County.

The roadway is heavily used by pedestrians going to the Bay Point/Pittsburg BART station, students going to and from school, users of the DeAnza Trail which bisects Bailey Road and a growing number of shoppers going to commercial areas on the north and south ends of the road.

Some of the major features that may be altered is the redesign of the Highway 4 exit ramps, wider sidewalks and the addition of more stoplights.

Supervisor Glover's Town Hall will be held at the Ambrose Center's dining room on Monday, May 24, 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m.

This planning phase for the roadway is paid for by the Port Chicago Naval Weapons Station Mitigation Fund, which was created when the Navy closed down the Port Chicago Highway.
