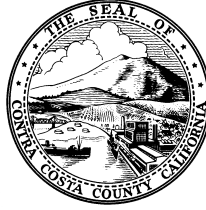

PITTSBURG (Jan. 7, 2011) -- Supervisor Federal Glover is sponsoring a free workshop that will teach the basics of how to write a successful application for a grant.

“In this economic climate, community-based organizations and agencies serving the public need to find alternate sources of funding in order to continue providing their services,” said Supervisor Glover.

“It is no secret that government sources are drying up,” he said. “CBOs and other government agencies need to look toward foundations and corporate-sponsored programs to find additional sources of income.”

“The CBOs are a valuable community resource. They make up part of the social safety net that keep families in their homes, provide services to the elderly and help so many people who many need assistance,” said Glover.
