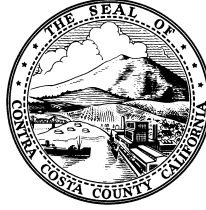

New commander makes history

Lt. Gwen Brady is the first African-American woman to reach her rank in the county's Office of the Sheriff.

Lt. Brady is the new commander of the Muir Station, which is responsible for Bay Point, the largest unincorporated community in Contra Costa County.

"Community policing and developing positive character enriched youth programs are among my highest priorities," she says. "I am very excited and proud to be back in such a warm-spirited community."
