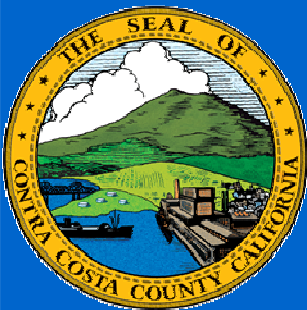

### VASCO DOUBLE FINE ZONE LEGISLATION


Last week, State Assembly Bill 348 (Buchanan) passed unanimously. The bill re-authorizes a Safety Enhancement-Double Fine Zone along Vasco Road.

I have advocated for increased safety along the notoriously dangerous Vasco Road corridor during my seven years as Supervisor, including the installation of vertical delineators and rumble strips.

I have been working with Assemblymember Buchanan on these safety improvements. State Assembly Bill 348 gives the authority to designate a Double Fine Zone in an attempt to prevent unsafe driving that has so often led to accidents and fatalities. This re-establishes the previous Senate Bill 3 (Torlakson) that originally designated the Vasco Road Safety-Enhancement Double Fine Zone from 2006-2010.

The bill is anticipated to go before Governor Brown sometime in October.

The work to continue the Vasco Road safety improvements continues next week as work to widen northbound Vasco Road and westbound Camino Diablo Road will be between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm. Lane closures are anticipated, during non-commute hours, on Monday, September 12, and Tuesday, September 13 for paving. Call Rob Tavenier of Contra Costa County Public
