c. Pacheco Town Council

Council Member Perry-Thayer reported the following:

- An person has been hired to staff the Community Center office on Fridays
- Community Center AC and Fence. Received estimates of \$6,000 to replace the AC unit; and \$800 to repair the fence
- The American Red Cross requested using the Community Center for a shelter in the event of an emergency, however, the Council would like to know who they can contact about that
 - Lynn Reichard-Enea suggested they contact Chris Balswin, with County EMS.
- The community center received a call from a citizen looking for contact information on creek cleanup
 - Chairman Fontana suggested they contact the County Flood Control

d. Supervisor Federal D. Glover's Office

Lynn Reichard-Enea reported the following:

- Public Works will be micro-surfacing Pacheco Blvd. from Arthur Road to Shell Road
- The PMAC has open positions, however the Supervisor's office has not received any applications. The vacancies will be reposted; applications are due July 23
- Deodar Drive restriping: 25 letters were sent, 16 were returned. Of those 11 support the restriping and 5 oppose it. Public works will go forward with restriping, however they will check whether any resurfing will be done on that street in the next year. If so, they will wait to restripe until that time; if not, then they will begin work soon.

Chairman Fontana requested an updated on the Martinez/Pacheco annexation. Lynn will get back to him with information.
