The three Contra Costa County seats include one Senate position and two Assembly positions. Terms for all seats are four years.

An informational meeting for interested candidates will take place Tuesday, March 11th, at 3:00 PM at Board Rooms A/B, 500 Ellinwood Way, in Pleasant Hill. Elections will be held Wednesday, May 21, 2014 at the monthly meeting of the Contra Costa County Advisory Council on Aging. The Advisory Council on Aging is the electing body.
