Let's ride to Honor and Remember the police officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty in the Bay Area.

The ride is also being held to support and "send off" the participants who will be riding in the Police Unity Tour which takes place May 9-12 in Washington D.C.

- 75 mile ride from Martinez to Sacramento
- Ride starts at the Contra Costa District Attorney's Office, at 900 Ward Street, in Martinez at 8:00 a.m.
- Ride ends at the California Peace Officer Memorial across from the State Capitol in Sacramento

The ride is "informal and not supported".

*The route starts at the District Attorney's Office in Martinez, crosses the Benicia Bridge, travels through Fairfield, Vacaville, Dixon, and Davis, to Sacramento. **We will ride at a Police Unity Tour pace.***

The route allows for the following:

- Rest stop at 35 miles. (Vacaville) - Refreshments on your own.
- Lunch at 60 miles. (Davis) - Lunch/Refreshments on your own.
- 75 miles - California Peace Officer Memorial across from the State Capitol in Sacramento.

25 Miles/ FAIRFIELD:

SUBWAY 2147 North Texas Street

FIRST STOP/35 MILES/VACAVILLE:

SUBWAY 1045 Alamo Street

50 Miles/DIXON:

MR. TACO (MEXICAN) 2600 Plaza Ct.

CARLS JR 125 Gateway Plaza

LUNCH/60 MILES/DAVIS:

BISTRO 33 226 F ST

(Numerous other eateries in the area.)

DIRECTIONS

BEGIN: Contra Costa D.A. Office, 900 WARD ST, Martinez

Court St to RT onto Escobar

Escobar becomes Marina Vista, Marina Vista to Bridgehead/Mococo Rd (Entrance to Benicia Bridge)

Go over the Benicia Bridge then RT onto Park Rd

Park Rd to RT onto Industrial Rd then LT onto Lake Herman

Lake Herman to RT onto Goodyear Rd. then LT on Marshview Rd.

Marshview Rd. to RT onto Lopes Rd.

Go down Lopes Rd. for several miles, over the overpass (I-80) to Green Valley Rd.

RT onto Business Center Dr. which will turn into Suisun Pkwy

LT on Abernathy Rd. then RT on Mankas Corner Rd which turns into Waterman

LT onto Hilborn Rd

LT onto Lyon Rd **(If you want to stop for lunch or snack Subway is a Rt. turn onto N. Texas)
(2147 North Texas Street) (Mile 25 in Fairfield)**

From Lyon Rd, RT onto Lagoon Valley Rd (over I 80)

Go through Pena Adobe Park to bike path and over to Butcher Rd.

Butcher Rd to Alamo Street

35 MILE STOP

(Subway in shopping Center at 1045 Alamo Street). (Mile 35 in Vacaville).

Butcher Rd LT on Alamo then RT on Buck St.

LT onto N. Orchard then RT onto Vaca Valley Pkwy

LT on Gibson Canyon Rd (Hills) then RT onto Cantelow then RT onto Midway Rd.

Go straight on Midway Rd. and LT onto N. Meridan Rd. then RT onto Dixon Av. Which turns into West A St.

(Once you cross I -80 there will be Carl's Jr and Mr. Taco on the left.) (Mile 50 in Dixon)

Go straight on West A then LT on Pitt School Rd.

Pitt School Rd. to RT onto Stratford Ave. then LT onto N. Lincoln

N. Lincoln will turn into Vaughn Rd then LT onto Runge Rd.

RT onto Tremont Rd. then LT onto Old Davis Rd.

Old Davis Rd. to RT onto Becker then LT onto Old Davis Rd.

Go through UC Davis Campus on Old Davis Rd. then RT onto First St.

LT onto B St. then RT onto 3RD St. then RT onto L St. then LT onto 2nd St.

LUNCH - (Bistro 33 and other eateries will be at 226 F Street) (Mile 60 in Davis)

Continue onto 2nd St. along the freeway then go straight past Mace Rd. and continue along I-80 to bike path that will take you to Causeway.

Go over the Causeway, then LT onto West Capitol then LT onto Tower Bridge Rd.

Go over the bridge and continue straight on Capitol Mall Rd to State Capitol. **(Memorial on right)**

If you plan to ride with us, please register so we can have an idea of how many riders will be participating, and so we can update you with any ride developments.

The ride is one- way so you will need to make arrangements for travel back to Martinez. The Amtrak station is very close to the Memorial and a ticket to Martinez costs \$19. The schedule:
