Contra Costa County Public Works to Close a Section of Marina Vista Street in Martinez Due to Construction of the New Administrative Building

July 17, 2018, Martinez, CA – Contra Costa County Public Works will close a section of Marina Vista Street from **July 18th** to **July 27th** for the installation of a new sanitary sewer for the new County Administration Building. Traffic control measures and traffic rerouting will be implemented starting on **July 18th**.

The street will be closed starting at approximately **8 A.M.** on **Wednesday, July 18th** and will re-open at approximately **5 P.M.** on **Friday, July 27th**, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
