

# Action 22:

## Support Sustainable Agricultural Activities Within the Corridor

### Description:

Support continued sustainable agriculture activities of the Bayseng Spice Company on their property above the eastern entrance to the Caldecott Tunnel. Bayseng sustainably harvests bay leaves from the bay forest on its property, grows spices and herbs in the under story of this forest and in small clearings, manages vegetation to reduce fire risks, and processes their harvests in a small facility at the eastern end of Old Tunnel Road directly adjacent to the Caltrans structure over the eastern Caldecott Tunnel entrance. These current activities are consistent with both maintaining the ecological function of the Caldecott Corridor and with controlling fire risks.
